Student Contract

I agree and understand the following:

- If I attend all study sessions
- If I wake up on time for the morning routine ie; breakfast, school and fitness
- If my school attendance is of the expected standard at AFLCY House ie 95%
- If I assist with Saturday morning clean up and other tasks at AFLCYH
- If I consistently follow instructions, show respect and work on becoming the best person I can be
- If I use my phone and digital equipment in a respectful and non-negative way ie: viewing content, non-disruptive to others.

I will get the responsibility of keeping my phone during the term. However, I understand that:

- I am responsible for my mobile phone
- I can have only **ONE** mobile phone at AFLCY House
- I do not take my mobile phone to meal times (and other times when asked by Duty Staff)
- I must inform Duty Staff if I change phones or phone numbers
- This contract includes any device that can connect to the internet for eg. **WIRELESS BROADBAND USBs**

If these key points that we have agreed on are not followed this contract will no longer be deemed valid and I will then fall under the junior terms and conditions with a new contract. This will then apply until I can demonstrate to the Residential Supervisors and Boarding Manager that I can handle the responsibility.
